At the time of the Pearl Harbor attack, there were five operational radar stations on Oahu, with a sixth additional station authorized, but not yet installed. Three fixed radar sites which would use the SCR-271 radar were planned, but not yet built. 2 It was the mobile station located at Opana Point, on the northern tip of Oahu, that detected the the incoming Japanese aircraft.

Seaman 2C D.T. Kyser was born in Muskogee in 1923 and was killed on Dec. 7, 1941, while serving onboard the USS Oklahoma, which was sunk during the Japanese attack on Pearl Harbor, Hawaii. At Pearl Harbor, the fleet was boxed together like sardines, making them ideal targets for bombers. In Hawaii, oil and others supplies had to be brought across 2,000 miles of the Pacific.
